Each unit will examine an aspect of working with people with mental health needs. This includes the role of the mental health worker, as well as the processes and approaches involved in providing this type of care and support. Learners will gain an understanding of sector standards and the factors which inform legislation and guidance. Training covers the principles of care planning, risk assessments, and wider agency involvement. They will also investigate how they can develop their own work role and maintain their own wellbeing.

The emphasis is on understanding the underlying processes, requirements and resources which are fundamental for best practice when working with people with mental health needs.
